Home-School Agreement

Allaah says: ***“Help one another in righteousness and piety...”*** (Sūrah al-Mā'idah: 2)

We acknowledge that a parent responsibility does not end when they enrol their child into the school and as such we expect some accountability and involvement in their child's learning.

Unique Academy is dedicated to ensuring that our school environment supports the children's Islamic development, academic learning and wellbeing. We aim to establish good relationships with staff, parents, guardians, and pupils, and believe that working together we can achieve more.

This agreement outlines Unique Academy's expectations of parents and pupils, and sets out what we aim to do, as a school body, to ensure that all pupils are given the best possible chance of a high quality Islamic and academic education and enjoyable school years at Unique Academy.

Unique Academy

We, as a school, will strive to:

- work hard and work with you to ensure that your child's *fitrah* is nourished to enable them to achieve their own potential
- make sure that every child feels like they are a valued member of our school community, by promoting our ethos of care, respect, inclusion, and equality
- provide a broad and balanced curriculum adjusted to meet the individual needs of your child
- instil a sense of independence and social responsibility in your child so that they can progress confidently through school and continue to do so after they leave
- help your child to achieve high standards of work and provide the support that they need to progress as they should Islamically and academically
- keep an open line of communication between you and the school, ensuring you are well informed of general developments within school and of your child's progress
- take all concerns that you might have seriously and be open to discussion, supporting you as a parent however you may need
- provide you with plenty of opportunities to become involved in the daily life of the school and your child's development.

Parents/Guardians

I, as parent(s) or guardian(s), will:

- ensure that my child attends school regularly
- ensure that my child reaches school on time, properly dressed, rested, fed, and equipped for the school day
- inform the school when my child is absent for any reason by calling 0208 004 5481 (Option 1) or sending an email to: office@uniqueacademy.education on each day of the absence.
- be open with the school and communicate any concerns that I have **with the school only** by sending an email to: office@uniqueacademy.education or by requesting a meeting
- communicate any knowledge that I have of problems or issues that may affect my child's work or behaviour
- operate in support of all of the Unique Academy's policies, the school Muslim ethos, and Islamic code of conduct, and set a good example to my child
- engage with the school in terms of my child's progress and development, attending parents' meetings when it is required or requested.

- Support the school's initiatives and activities with regards to fundraising, raising the profile of the school in the community, looking for alternative suitable premises in the case that we need to relocate, and helping around the school when it is requested.
- Support my child with their homework activities
- I will ensure that my child attends remote learning classes and I will support them to complete any homework tasks that they are set and submit these to the class teacher at the time and date specified.
- In the cases where the school must provide remote learning following government guidelines due to local or national restrictions, I will continue to pay my fees as required by the school.

Pupils

I, as a pupil at Unique Academy, I will:

- ensure that I am at school regularly and on time, dressed smartly and in line with the school uniform guidelines, with the right equipment for the day ahead
- respect my peers, staff, and all other members of the school community
- respect the authority of school staff and follow any instructions that they give me
- act in line with all school policies and behave in accordance with the school behaviour policy
- respect the school building and the environment, making sure that I clean up after myself and do not litter
- take responsibility for my actions
- be polite and helpful at all times, make all visitors to the school feel welcome, and support and look out for all my fellow pupils.
- actively take part in classroom learning activities as well as doing homework tasks
- I will attend remote learning classes, participate as well as complete and submit the set homework tasks on time
