

<p>Science - Humans</p> <p>In Science, the children will be learning about animals including humans. They will learn to classify animals into five groups: mammals, fish, birds, reptiles & amphibians.</p> <p>They will learn how to identify the group an animal belongs to by its features and the different diets animals have.</p> <p>They will also continue to learn about humans and the five senses: sight, hearing, smell, taste and touch.</p>	<p>Mathematics</p> <p>The children will continue to build on what they have learnt previously about numbers and apply this to addition and subtraction facts. There will also be a focus on developing their mental maths.</p> <p>The children will discuss money and the coins needed to buy items and the change they will receive. They will also learn about weight, time, position and direction. We will continue to count in steps of 2, 5 and 10s.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Children will be building on what they learnt in Computing in Autumn term about online safety. They will also learn about digital citizenship and digital searching.</p> <p>Computing will be linked to the theme Bright Lights, Big City and children will be looking at aerial perspective and roaming around London.</p>	<p>English</p>  <p>In English, we will be reading the book 'The Whales Song' and learning interesting facts about these Wondrous creatures! The children will then write a report about Humpback Whales which they will share in our school assembly.</p> <p>The children will also learn how to write instructions and how to use time connectives correctly. In Poetry, they will listen to various poems and learn to write their very own poem!</p> <p>In Grammar, Year 1 will focus on using the correct punctuation while Year 2 will focus on adjectives and using expanded noun phrases.</p>
<div>  <p>Spring Term 1</p> <h2>Bright Lights, Big City</h2> <p>This project teaches children about the physical and human characteristics of the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the characteristics and features of the capital city, London.</p> </div>			
<p>Halaqah (PSHEC)</p> <p>We will continue to discuss the purpose of life and the stages of human life linking back to Tawheed. They will also learn about Tarikh and about the lives of Prophet Adam (AS) and Prophet Nuh (AS). They will also continue to perform daily salah.</p> <p>Arabic: The children will learn the words for family members.</p> <p>Qur'aan: Surah Takathur, Surah Qariah, Surah Adiyat, Surah Zalzal and Surah Qadr.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>In History, the children will be learning about London and its history. We will discuss transport and the different ways people travelled in the past and then look at famous landmarks.</p> <p>The children will step back in time and learn about key events, for example, they will discover what happened in the Great Fire of London.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>In Geography, children will build on what they have learnt previously in the Autumn term. They will focus on life in the United Kingdom as well as the physical features of the United Kingdom.</p> <p>They will look at a map and discuss what makes a capital city and what the weather is like in the United Kingdom.</p>	<p>Art</p>  <p>The children will explore line and shape, including how to make a weather motif. Children will be encouraged to use natural materials, such as grass, pebbles, sand, leaves, pine cones and flowers in their art work.</p> <p>Design and Technology</p> <p>Children will discuss Taxi vehicles and will be investigating parts of the taxi such as the axles, wheels and the chassis before designing and creating a moving model of taxi.</p>
