



<p>Science - Wild and Wonderful Creatures</p> <p>In Science, children will learn about animals including humans - wild and wonderful creatures. In this unit, children will learn about five of the groups that scientists use to classify animals: mammals, fish, birds, reptiles and amphibians.</p> <p>They will learn to identify the group an animal belongs to by its features and will classify animals according to their group. They will also learn about the different diets of animals .</p> <p>Children will use scientific language to name and identify animals that are herbivore, carnivore or omnivore.</p> <p>As part of this theme, we will be visiting Hobbledown Heath and taking part in an 'Animal Encounter Experience' workshop. Children will meet with farm animals and discuss habitats and features of the animals with a qualified animal keeper.</p>	<p>Mathematics Place value, Fractions, Measurements</p> <p>Children will focus on place value and will compare and order two digit numbers using place value. They will count in 10s and say 10 more and 10 less. This will help them when adding and subtracting 10, 20 and 30.</p> <p>Children will learn about fractions and finding halves and quarters of an object, shape or quantity. They will also learn about measurement and will compare and solve practical problems using measurements. They will discuss the length and height, mass / weight, capacity and volume.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Children will continue to create and debug simple programmes using the 'Scratch JR' programme.</p> <p>Children will recognise simple uses of information technology beyond school and will know how to be confident and creative users of communication technology. They will continue learning about programming and debugging.</p> <p>Computing will be linked to the theme Bright Lights, Big City and children will be looking at aerial perspective of London and the world map.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>In English, we will be looking at Fictional stories with repeated patterns, including 'We're going on a Lion Hunt', 'Handa's Hen' and 'We All Went On Safari'.</p> <p>The children will also explore Non-Fiction stories about letters and descriptions including 'Mr Postmouse's Rounds and 'Dear Postman'.</p> <p>In Poetry, they will listen to various poems, including 'Sensational!' which is a poem inspired by the five senses. They will also read poems from 'The Works' which will include a range of poems to get them inspired.</p> <p>In Grammar, children will focus on using 's' and 'es' to form regular plurals correctly. They will also be adding the suffixes 'ing' and 'ed' to root words.</p>
<p>Halaqah</p> <p>Children will learn about the Seerah of Prophet Mohammed (pbuh). They will discuss his childhood, his youth and his marriage to Khadijah (RA)</p> <p>Arabic</p> <p>Speaking & Listening, Reading & Writing: Children learn about pets, colours and physical descriptions of Ramadan and Eid.</p> <p>Qur'aan</p> <p>Surah Qadr, Surah Teen, Surah Inshirah abd Surah Maun.</p> 	<div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Year 1: Spring Term 2 - Theme - Bright Lights, Big City</p> <p>In Spring Term 1, children learnt about the physical features of London and the United Kingdom. They discussed the countries that made up the United Kingdom and used positional and directional language to plan routes to the famous landmarks in London. This term, children will learn about significant events in the past and will research the cause and impact of the Great Fire of London. They will learn about Queen Elizabeth II and her reign before ending the term with a royal garden tea party!</p> <p>SCHOOL TRIP: Spring 2 - 01.03.24 - Hobbledown Heath (linked to Science topic)</p> </div>	<p>Design and Technology</p> <p>Taxi! - This project teaches children about wheels, axles and chassis and how they work together to make a vehicle move. Children will investigate the various components before they experiment and explore ways to make their own model Taxi.</p> <p>PE</p> <p>Children will be learning multi skills including bat and ball. They will focus on how to correctly hold a racket, striking a ball with control, following rules of the game and working cooperatively as a team.</p>
