

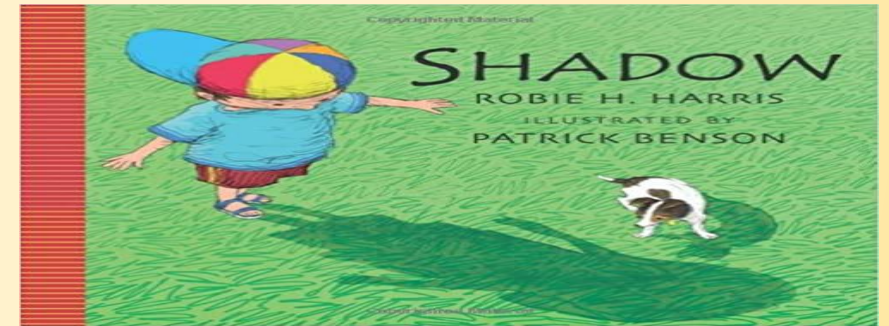

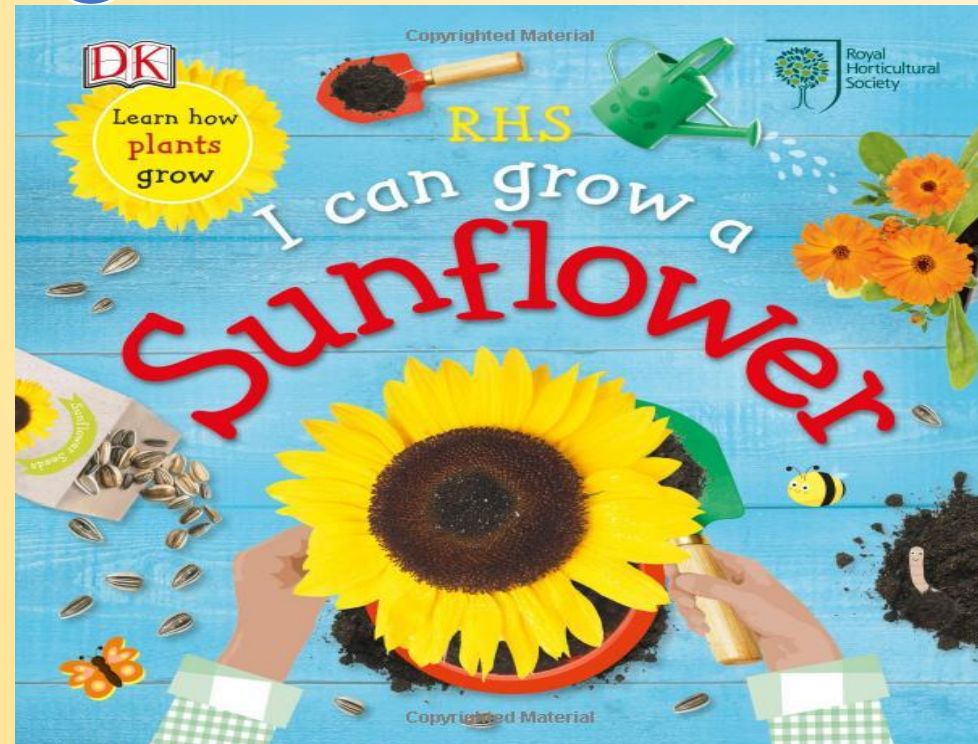

Summer Term –1 Sunshine and Sunflowers, Shadows and Reflections

Personal, Social and Emotional Development		Communication and Language		Physical Development	
In this theme, children will develop their understanding of each season of the year. They explore the natural world around them, making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants. They will learn to express their ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences with modelling and support from their teacher. They manage their own basic hygiene and personal needs, including dressing, going to the toilet, and understanding the importance of healthy food choices.		Children will learn to listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class discussions and small group interactions. Children will learn to hold a conversation, back-and-forth exchanges with their teacher and peers. Children will learn to express their ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences, including use of past, present, and future tense, and making use of conjunctions, with modelling and support from their teacher.		Children will experience gardening by using compost, seeds and plants. They will learn about the features of a plant, such as leaves, seeds and flowers. Children will learn to move energetically, such as running, jumping, dancing, hopping, skipping and climbing. Children will learn to use a range of small tools, including scissors, paint brushes and cutlery.	
Literacy		Mathematics		Understanding the World	
Children will demonstrate an understanding of what is read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary. They will use and understand recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, non fiction, rhymes, and poems and during role-play. They will learn to say a sound for each letter in the alphabet and at least 10 digraphs. They will read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound-blending. They will read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.		Using White Rose Maths, children will learn about: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Numerical patterns• Subitising• Make games and actions• Shape, space and measure• Number		Children will explore the natural world around them, making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants. Children will develop scientific knowledge through play activities, sharing stories and non-fiction books and discussion. Children will learn to sort group materials and resources and talk about how they are similar or different.	
		Expressive Arts and Design			
		Children will learn to listen to a variety of sounds, take part in imaginative, creative and sensory play activities. Children will learn to test their ideas, being imaginative and expressive. Children will learn to invent, adapt and recount narratives and stories with peers and their teacher. Children will learn to safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. Children will share their creations, explaining the process they have used.			



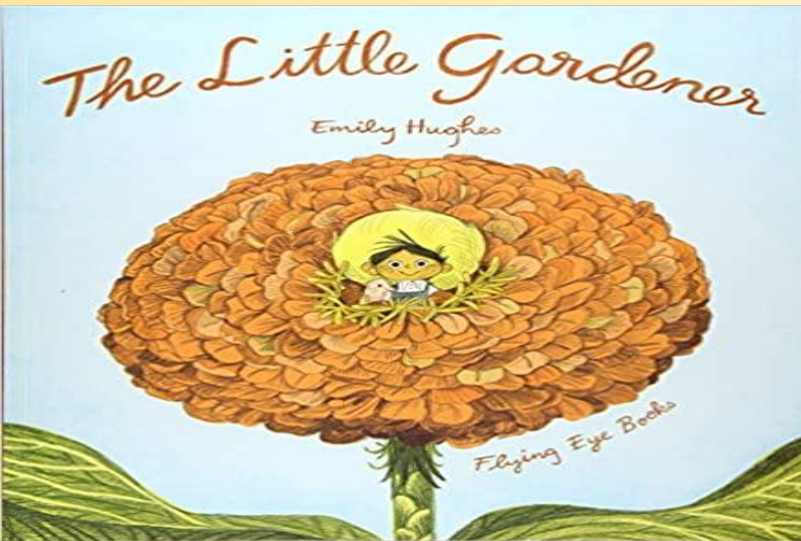
