






Children will demonstrate an understanding of what is read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary. They will use and understand recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, non fiction, rhymes, and poems and during role-play. They will learn to say a sound for each letter in the alphabet and at least 10 digraphs. They will read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound-blending. They will read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.
