


<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Human Senses</p> <p>Children will name and count body parts and identify similarities and differences. Children will learn about the senses, the body parts associated with each sense and their role in keeping us safe.</p> <p>They will also develop an understanding of what a mammal is and that humans are a type of mammal. This will lead to a deeper connection to humans and the environment around them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Number: Place value & Shapes</p> <p>Children will continue to consolidate their learning of place value and partitioning numbers into tens and units. They will learn numbers up to 100. Along with understanding 2D and 3D shapes especially about their properties and identifying each shape.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Children will learn how to effectively use a search program and how to navigate a search program such as Internet Explorer or Chrome. They will learn the different parts of a search screen and how to search clearly to conduct research in the future. Also, will be using a program called Lego Builders to work collaboratively to create objects online.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>The children will be exploring a wide range of texts including fiction and non fiction. Children will focus on writing instructions on how to make a sandwich along with a narrative specifically focusing on cause and effect.</p> <p>Key texts: A Magic Porridge pot, nursery rhymes and writing instructions.</p> <p>Grammar: Using adjectives. Punctuation:</p> <p>Yr 1 and 2: Capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, speech marks and conjunctions.</p>

They will explore artefacts to help them to understand childhood in the past and how childhood has changed over time. They will explore the six stages of life and explore timelines and family trees. Everyday life in the 1950s will be explored, including shopping, transport, family life and childhood. They will also learn about the significance of Queen Elizabeth II's coronation in 1953 by studying photographs and online sources.</p> </div> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>History Childhood</u></p> <p>The children will learn about everyday life and families today, including comparisons with childhood in the 1950s, using artefacts and a range of different sources.</p> <p>Children will learn to read a timeline and understand how timelines are used to record major events.</p> <p>Children will look at a range of family trees before beginning to create their own family tree.</p> <p>They will have a deeper understanding of events in the past and the progression of childhood for different generations.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>The children will learn about the purpose of shade and shelters and their materials. They will name and describe shelters and make prototypes. They will then design and build a play den as a group and evaluate their completed product.</p> <p>The children will be able to identify different shelters and know what suitable materials are needed to make a shelter.</p>
